GUIDELINES

Award

A scholarship of \$1,000, once each semester (twice a year), to provide financial support towards tuition for women who attend the University of Advancing Technology in Tempe, Arizona.

Eligibility

Scholarships will be awarded on a competitive basis to deserving students who in the judgment of the UAT Scholarship Committee best demonstrate the academic and creative qualifications needed to succeed in the field of computer game development and design. The Scholarship Committee will consider the academic performance and financial need of scholarship applicants.

Applicant must be:

• A current UAT female resident gamer with a cumulative High School GPA of 3.0 or higher or a cumulative college GPA of 3.0 or higher who also demonstrates financial need.

Essay Format

Submissions must be the original, unpublished work of the applicant.

Scholarship Distribution

- Award recipient will be named in July for fall semester and January for spring semester and notified by letter.

- The Award check will be distributed by the end of each semeseter.
